



United States Visa Physical Examination

Items to bring

- 1) Original valid passport.
- 2) Case number letter (Letter from US Embassy)
- 3) 4 photographs (Height 4cm x Length 3cm)
- 4) Vaccination records, if any
- 5) Pregnant or possibly pregnant patients must present an official document to prove your pregnancy (please inform the receptionist when you book an appointment. You must undergo a chest X-ray to complete this physical exam. The pelvic area will be protected. Please consult your obstetrician if you have any concerns.)
- 6) Applicants with a serious medical condition should bring detailed information regarding treatment and/or current health status.
- 7) Applicants with history of Tuberculosis should inform us when booking an appointment (If you have a previous chest X-ray film, a medical certificate from the doctor who treated the tuberculosis condition and details of the prescribed medication, please bring them on the physical examination day.)
- 8) Children under 6 years old should bring their "Mother & Child Notebook" if available.
- 9) Glasses or contact lenses (if worn)

Test requirements + Cost

Age	Contents of Examination	Cost
0-14	Measurements, Doctor's consultation, Tuberculin skin test (Children aged 2-14 may require a Tuberculin skin test which will be decided by the doctor. The child will have to return in 48 hours to have the results read if this test is done)	15,120 yen 18,360 yen (if Tuberculin skin test is done) ** Additional chest x-ray fees of approx. 6,480-9,940 yen will be added if the tuberculin test result is positive**
15 and older	Measurements, Doctor's consultation, Chest X-ray, Syphilis blood test, gonorrhoea urine test	31,320 yen

* Vaccination fees are not included in the price above.

* If all the required vaccinations are administered the total cost could add to more than 70,000 yen for applicants aged 15 and older; or more than 100,000 yen for applicants under age 15.

* Urgent/ Expedited service is available for an additional 8,640 yen only for certain age groups.

Additional tests are required for each case below.

- 1) Applicants whose Tuberculin skin test is positive --- Chest X-ray

- 2) Applicants with a history of Tuberculosis --- TB sputum & culture tests
(The samples must be obtained on 3 consecutive days. The results will be available within 10 weeks. If your appointment at the US Embassy has been already made, please contact them to reschedule.)
- 3) Applicants who do not have official vaccination records may choose to do antibody tests for measles, mumps, rubella, and varicella. These results will be available in 3-4 working days. You will need to be vaccinated if any of these results are negative.

Antibody test

It will take about 3-4 working days to obtain these test results. If your results are negative, you will need to be vaccinated. You may come back to our clinic for vaccinations, or receive them at a local medical facility. If you choose to have vaccinations at another medical facility, we will need the original proof of vaccination issued by that facility in order to complete your report.

Vaccinations

The requirements of vaccinations vary depending on your age. In some cases vaccinations can be exempt:

- 1) Applicants who have an official record of the applicable vaccinations.
- 2) Applicants who have been affected by Varicella
- 3) Live vaccinations, (Measles, Mumps, Rubella and Varicella) are exempt for pregnant applicants.
- 4) All vaccinations are exempt for applicants applying for IR-3/IR-4 (Orphans, Refugees and adopted children aged 10 and under.)

Report Completions

Normal Service

Age 0-14: Report will be completed in 3-4 working days (if tuberculin/TB skin test not done)

(If a TB skin test is done, report completions for Negative results: will take 3-4 working days from the initial visit; for positive results: approximately 1 week from the initial visit)

Age 15 and older: 4-5 working days

Urgent Service

Age 0-1: Report will be ready by 5pm on the same day.

(The last urgent service appointment is 11:00 am)

Age 2-14: Not available

Age 15 and older: Not available

** The above time frames for report completions apply only to applicants with normal results and have no medical issues **
