



Canada Visa Physical Examination

Items to bring

- 1) Original Valid passport
- 2) Medical Report from the Canadian Embassy. (Not required for Family Class applicants.)
- 3) Pregnant or possibly pregnant applicants a document to certify your pregnancy (please inform the receptionist when you book an appointment. You must undergo a chest x-ray to complete this physical exam. The pelvic area will be protected. Please consult your obstetrician if you have any concerns.)
- 4) Applicants with a serious medical condition should bring detailed information regarding past treatment and/or prognosis.
- 5) "Mother and Child's book" (if available) for children 6 years old and under.
- 6) Glasses or contact lenses (if worn). Corrected vision must be better than 0.5, 20/40 or 6/12 in the better eye.

Precautions

- Fasting is not required, and a photo will be taken at our clinic.
- **Female applicants:** please avoid coming in during menstruation, as urine samples cannot be collected. If you are menstruating on the day of your appointment, you will have to come back to do the urine test after your period has completely finished.
- **Applicants with High Blood Pressure:** Your blood pressure should be controlled with medicine.

Test requirements and costs

Please be aware that **the consumption tax is NOT included** in the cost below.

Consumption tax will be added at the time of payment. All units of one yen will be rounded up by 10yen.

Age	Content of Examination	Cost
0-4	Measurement Consultation	¥10,000
5-10	Measurement, Consultation, Urine test	¥14,000
11-14	Measurement, Consultation, Urine test, Chest X-ray	¥17,500
15 and over	Measurement, Consultation, Urine test, Chest X-ray, HIV and Syphilis blood test	¥25,400

Additional tests are required for cases below

(Those additional tests are exempt for Family Class Applicants)

Case	Additional Test	Cost
Applicants with high blood pressure	Blood test for creatinine and cardiology report	The cost will vary according to each case
Applicants with diabetes, kidney disease	Blood test for creatinine	
Applicants with hepatitis or extensive tattoos	Blood test for ALT, AST, Hepatitis B and C	

Examination Results

All results will be sent electronically directly to Canadian Immigration and Citizenship (CIC) via e-medical. The result will be sent within 3-4 working days (not including Saturdays/ Sundays/ holidays). This will apply only to applicants without any medical issues. If there is an abnormal finding in your examination, we will contact you as soon as possible.
