

Australia Visa Physical Examination

Items to bring

- 1) Original valid passport
- 2) Referral letter or Health Examination list from the Australian Embassy. (Printed hard copy)
- 3) Proof of pregnancy (medical certificate/ mother-baby book) for pregnant or possibly pregnant applicants.
- Applicants with history of TB or serious medical condition(s) should bring a medical report with detailed information noting treatment and/or prognosis <u>in English</u> from their treating doctor.
- 5) "Mother and Child's book" (if available) for children 6 years old and under.
- 6) Glasses or contact lenses (if worn). Corrected vision must be better than 0.5, 20/40 or 6/12 in the better eye.
- 7) Vaccination records (if applicable- see Precautions below Regarding Polio Virus)
- 8) Vaccination record for Covid-19 (if available). Please bring paper copies of shot records (no apps).

** <u>Please bring printed hard copies of all proof documents (medical certificates, vaccination records, etc.)</u> <u>No</u> <u>digital files, photos, or apps.</u> **

Precautions

- Examinations are performed by appointment only (no walk-ins).
- Fasting is not required for this examination.
- Photos will be taken on site.
- The examination will take approximately 2 hours (for one applicant). Applicants will be called in order of appointment time (not in the order of arrival or check in).
- <u>Please come at the set appointment time</u>. Examinations cannot be started early for those who come early. Please avoid coming in 1-2+ hours before your appointment time.
- Female applicants may undergo the medical during menstruation. Please inform our staff if you are pregnant.
- Regarding Polio Virus: Due to the on-going risk of polio transmission, clients who have lived in certain countries for 4 weeks or more are required to show proof of polio vaccination within the last 12 months. If no vaccination records are available, polio vaccination will be given at the time of examination.
- When taking the chest x-ray: You will be asked to remove clothing covering the upper body (including shirts/ undershirts/ bras/ tank tops, etc.) before taking the chest x-ray. Please avoid clothing that cannot be taken off quickly such as dresses/ overalls/ jumpsuits/ bodysuits, etc. The pelvic area will be protected for pregnant applicants. Please consult your obstetrician if you have any concerns. The chest x-ray must be performed to complete this examination.

Test requirements and costs

Please be aware that the consumption tax is NOT included in the cost below.

Consumption tax will be added at the time of payment. All units of one yen will be rounded up to the nearest 10 yen. Accepted forms of payment: cash or credit card (Visa/ Mastercard/ AMEX/ JCB/ Diners/ Discover)

15 and over	Measurement, Consultation, Chest X-ray, HIV, serum creatinine/ eGFR (blood test)	¥25,400

** For applicants aged 5-14: the serum creatinine/ eGFR blood test may be added if there are risk factors for chronic kidney disease. An additional 4,500 yen + tax will be added to the basic charge if done **

Additional tests are required for cases below

Case	Additional Test	Cost
Pregnant Applicants	Blood test for Hepatitis B	¥5,500
Health Sector employees and Medical Practitioners	Blood test for Hepatitis B and C, and HIV	¥12,500
Adopted Children	Blood test for Hepatitis B and HIV	¥9,500
Applicants who have had blood transfusions, tattoos, Hepatitis B	Blood test for Hepatitis B and C	¥8,500
Travelers over 70	ECG if required	¥8,000

Examination Results

All results will be submitted electronically directly to the Department of Home Affairs via the e-medical system. The result will be submitted within 3-4 working days (not including Saturdays/ Sundays/ holidays). This will apply only to applicants without medical issues. Our office will contact you if there are any abnormal findings.
